*Heavy machinery is being used throughout the Bowston weir removal process, with the weir being notched out in stages using a large-tracked machine with a pecker attachment.*

*It should be noted that that whilst residents are within their rights to watch the weir removal from their own property, fragments of concrete are being displaced during removal works.*

*We kindly ask residents to keep an appropriate distance from the working area and/or heavy machinery at all times, to avoid potential incident or injury.*
