## **A BOWSTON UPDATE**

Here at South Cumbria Rivers Trust, we have been working with our design and technical teams to arrange the removal of Bowston weir, expected to take place this summer 2022.

We have now appointed our contractor, Ebsford Environmental, who are leading aquatic restoration contractors experienced with large weir removals.

We want to inform you that enabling works, from the left bank downstream of the weir, will begin next week. Tree removal, as specified in our Tree Impact Assessment, will be carried out from Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May to Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2022. This will allow for the delivery work to begin promptly Mid-June 2022. Our contractors are due to be on site for mobilisation at the beginning of June to set the site boundary and the footpath diversion will be established thereafter.

It is our intention to invite residents to a site visit at the end of May 2022 with SCRT and our contractors to ask questions about the delivery phase of the project.

We will continue to update all interested parties with new developments and relevant information as soon as possible, via e-mail and on our website.
