## **BOWSTON- A BRIEF UPDATE**

South Cumbria Rivers Trust (SCRT) began investigations into this weir removal proposal in 2017. In early 2018 the proposal was first brought to a meeting of Bowston residents from which later emerged the Local Community Engagement Plan (LCEP). Through the LCEP we have worked to inform, update and share the viewpoints of all interested parties including the weir owner, residents, local Parish Councils and interest groups.

In late February 2020, SCRT met again with local residents, Burneside Parish Council & South Lakeland District Council representatives to discuss the proposal in more detail and to hear each other's views. Unfortunately, various constraints created through the COVID-19 pandemic and the subsequent furlough of SCRT staff, has delayed the collation and publication of the summary of notes from this meeting. However, these notes and answers to questions raised in this meeting are now being complied and will be posted to the SCRT website over the coming days.
