10.00am : Brief Introduction

10.15am: **Buffer Strip Surveys.** Working with Butterfly Conservation we have been developing buffer strip surveys to assess how areas along rivers re-generate after fencing, by recording vegetation, butterflies and freshwater invertebrates.

12.30 – 13.00: Lunch (Please bring a packed lunch)

13.00 : **Riverfly Surveys in the Beck.** Riverflies such as mayfly, stonefly and caddisfly are good indicators of water quality, and a great way for volunteers to monitor local becks.



14.00: **Electrofishing demonstration.** This is a method for fish surveys undertaken by South Cumbria Rivers Trust.
